5) The JANUS DECISION - The NTU, and every union across the country is anticipating a decision by the US Supreme Court within the next two months on the JANUS v AFSCME case (The JANUS case). This case is another attack on Unions of every kind and its decision may have IMMEDIATE ramifications. We are cooperating with our State and National unions to develop a plan of action should the decision come down against unions. Now

more than ever, we must remain UNION STRONG and UNITED.

AFL-CIO also has a online Petition to tell the U.S. Supreme Court: Protect working people's rights to organize, and stop dangerous right-to-work laws that hurt working people!
