Rules:

- 1) NTU members may nominate any other member of the NTU using the attached application. Members may not nominate themselves. Applications must be received at the NTU office by Friday, March 29, 2018.
- 2) The application also has room for up to three Supporting Statements. Applications MUST have at least one Supporting Statement to be considered, but the more the better.
- 3) Candidates should:
 - a. Be an NTU member in good standing.
 - b. Be exceptional, dedicated, and knowledgeable.
 - c. Have energy, enthusiasm, a positive attitude, and dependability.
 - d. Inspire students of all backgrounds and abilities to learn and succeed.
 - e. Have the respect and admiration of colleagues, students, and parents.
 - f. Play an active role in the school community.
- 4) The nominator MUST secure permission of the nominee to enter his/her name for consideration. If we receive one complete nomination form for a particular nominee, that member is considered nominated.
- 5) For schools with a Building Rep and/or Executive Board member, the NTU will be reaching out to the Rep (or Executive Board member) and Building Committee to review candidates. For schools without Building Reps, NTU will may reach out to the School Improvement Panel to help in the decision process.
- 6) Applicants will be pre-screened by the NTU staff before being given to the impartial selection committee who will make the final decision using the above criteria.
- 7) There will be a limit of two nominations per school, so please coordinate with your Building Rep/Committee and/or colleagues. If we received more than two nominations from a school, the two most senior members of the union in good standing will be considered.
- 8) There will be a maximum of ten teachers selected, preferably 2 from each ward.

- Week of April 1st-5th NTU selection committee will meet to review applications and select recipients
- Week of April 8th-12th Recipients will be notified
