
NEWARK TEACHERS UNION UPDATE

Unfortunately, as happens sometimes, some of our principals tried to exercise autonomy and put their own interpretations on what was happening, and a lot of confusion was created.

If I am currently waiving my benefits or want to stay on my current plan, do I have to do anything?

YES!! The default for everyone will be to move to the new NJEHP plan. If you want to waive your benefits or move to a different plan, you must select that during the open enrollment period from November 2 to November 30. EVERYONE MUST COMPLETE THE ENROLLMENT PROCESS!!!

What is a Flexible Spending Account?

We posted a terrific YouTube video explaining FSA's. on our YouTube Channel. You must be signed up during open enrollment as it becomes effective Jan 1, 2021. If you don't sign up now you have to wait until the following year. The limits for 2021 are \$2750 for health costs and \$5000 child care costs.

If I move to the NJEHP, what happens to my prescription?

IMPORTANT! Anyone who selects the NJEHP will have to take the NJEHP Prescription Plan as well. There are some big differences with the prescription plan including co-pays and what prescriptions are covered, so take that into consideration when making your decision.

How do I know if I am an NTU Member?

The easiest way is to check your paystub. If it says "Union Dues/NTU" under "After-Tax Deductions" then you are a NTU Member! Not being a member is like expecting a piece of teacher's lounge pizza without contributing to the pizza party!

What is COPE?

Under the law, Unions cannot use dues money for political reasons. Because of this, we ask our members to consider making voluntary contributions to NTU's COPE (Committee on Political Education) Fund. NTU COPE is responsible for building a political structure that can communicate the union's goals and objectives through legislation, by working with government officials at the local, state and national level, and by being effective in organizing campaigns.

This includes organizing members around important legislative issues and elections.

So why are we mentioning this right now? The runoff election for the two open Senates seats is of key importance to us. It's the difference between ensuring President Biden and Vice President Harris can move forward their agenda or staying with the Corporate Reform model DeVos has spread. The NTU COPE will be sending support to our brothers and sisters in Georgia!
