Colleagues,

As we get closer to our presumptive return to in-person instruction on April 12th, the NTU continues to meet regularly with the Superintendent and his staff to discuss the concerns of our members.

- Updated Surveys for Staff and Family— Next week, surveys will be going out to staff and students to access their willingness to return to in person instruction. As we have said numerous times, fill out these surveys and encourage your students' families to fill them out! They make a huge difference!
- **Non-Compliance**—Any student that refuses to comply with district, state, and CDC guidelines regarding social distancing, masking, etc will have to do remote instruction for the rest of the school year. We will be monitoring this situation closely to ensure that there are no loopholes or exceptions.
- **Student COVID Testing**—We continue to be active working with the district and community to put in place student testing procedures.
- Individual School Procedures—Your administrator should be in contact with you soon in regards to scheduling, ingress and egress procedures, and other issues. Please let us know where questions or problems seem to be coming up. We will be doing dress rehearsals prior to reopening so it will be done right the first time!
- **Building Walkthroughs**—We will be working closely with the Superintendent and Facilities office to ensure that all schools are as safe as possible by April 12th. More info to come on how these walkthroughs will work. We want to be thorough without putting staff in unnecessary risk.

We are also meeting regularly with our colleagues in the AFT to discuss best practices and what has worked (and not worked) throughout the country. Please continue to seek out, register and get the vaccine as soon as possible!


