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President's Report

Nationwide, *teacher* shortages continue to be <u>widespread especially</u> in <u>urban areas</u>. A survey found that 48% of teachers said they had considered changing jobs in the past month.

Why are *teachers* leaving education? "A culture of teacher blame and punitive test-based evaluation, have taken a toll...Even before the onslaught of the pandemic in March 2020, current and prospective teachers were responding to widespread devaluing of the profession by choosing other careers. Perhaps not surprisingly, the

pandemic has heightened the teacher shortage. As one teacher from Washington state recently put it, "Many of us are pouring from that empty cup from last year; we are emotionally exhausted."

In Newark, in April alone we had 27 teachers resign, and that's not counting several more who announced their retirement. That is why the district has asked us to reopen the current contract in a limited scope to look at *teacher* recruitment and retention. We continue to make progress in these negotiations and expect we will be able to give more information soon.

BUT, changes to the contract AREN'T enough! There are many issues at the school level that affect teachers as well as supports staff are not governed by our contract. That does not mean that we can not work to address them. Among these issues are workload, redundant tasks, and the lack of clear and consistent communication. We are working with the Superintendent's office to address these issues. We believe that this two-pronged approach will help to attract new teachers to the profession and give veteran staff reason to stay! WE NEED NEW TEACHERS TO BUILD THE FUTURE OF EDUCATION AND THE EXPERTISE OF VETERAN STAFF TO MENTOR THEM!



Reminder! Today's paycheck is a "third check" so benefits deductions were not taken out. BUT, the district had advanced us four days pay in our first check of the



year, so for most ten month employees, today's check is only for 9 days. To check your pay, take your salary and divide it by 214 days to get your daily rate. Multiple that by 9, and that should be your gross pay on today's check.
