 - What is the goal of the workshop
 - What will members know or be able to do upon completion of your workshop
 - Who is this workshop for
 - Grade level
 - Content area
 - Needs based (discipline issues, lesson development, data collection etc)
 - What materials are required to present
 - What materials should attendees bring
4. Workshops must be relevant and important to members
