

What Are Flexible Spending Accounts?

Want to reduce your taxable income and increase your take home pay? Enroll in an FSA and start saving money on eligible health care and/or dependent care expenses.



Great reasons to enroll in a health care FSA:

- Contribute pretax dollars from your paycheck, up to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) limit of \$2,600.
- Pay for eligible health care expenses for you, your spouse and/or your tax dependents. Such expenses may include: - Copays, coinsurance and deductibles - Dental expenses like orthodontia, crowns and bridges - Vision expenses like LASIK laser eye surgery, glasses and contacts - Prescription drugs and eligible over-the-counter (OTC) items.

Great reasons to enroll in a dependent care account:

- Contribute pretax dollars from your paycheck (minimum \$100; maximum \$5,000 Joint, \$2,500 Separate)
- Pay for eligible child and adult care expenses, such as: - Day care - Before and after school care - Preschool and nursery school - Summer day camp.
