Contract Update—MA/PhD Survey



Dear Colleagues,

Last week, many of you were emailed a survey from the Newark Public Schools about placing staff on the correct salary guide based on their degree. We have received numerous questions about the email, so we wanted to clarify.

First, some context: upon ratification of the 2012 contract, NPS was required to set up a committee that would review all subsequent advanced degrees attained by staff to determine eligibility for a \$20,000.00 cash stipend. They failed to meet this requirement and no money was ever paid out. The NTU filed a grievance that was ultimately decided six years later agreeing

with us that NPS violated the contract. This was appealed numerous times by NPS, but the decision was upheld.

When discussing the issue with our members over the years, the request that came up time and again was staff wanted us to return to the traditional BA, MA, and PhD guides. In November 2018, we got the district to agree, in writing, to work with us on putting the original time-tested system back in place during our next contract negotiations. Any current staff that started and finished their degree between October 2012 and the signing date of this agreement (November 14, 2018) would get the newly negotiated salaries paid retroactively to when they finished their degrees. To be eligible for the retroactive payment, you have to have been hired before October 2012 and still be in the NTU Bargaining unit.

Moving forward ALL STAFF will be placed on the proper guide.

The survey that was sent out is to address STRICTLY this portion of the settlement "Any current employees that started and finished their degree between October 2012 and the signing date of this agreement (November 14, 2018) would get the newly negotiated salaries paid retroactively to when they finished their degrees." If you fall in that category, YOU MUST FILL OUT THE SURVEY. This information is vital to ensure all eligible staff will be put on the proper guides and paid RETROACTIVELY, as agreed to in our Arbitration Settlement. Make sure you have a copy of your transcript ready to include with the submission. All staff that received the survey are encouraged to fill out the survey so that NPS will have a record of your name and current degree held.

This doesn't address any advancement for a degree achieved before or after the above dates. Those staff will be placed on the proper guides, and the final details are still being sorted out in negotiations.
