MA/PhD Survey Clarification

We have had a lot of questions this week about the surveys that NPS has sent out regarding moving staff to the Masters and PhD guides once we have a new contract. There are two separate surveys, each addressing a different situation.

- Survey 1 (Retro Survey) For staff who got their degree between Oct 2015 and November 2018 and are entitled to retro, that is the survey NPS sent out a month ago, and NTU (as well as NPS) sent out reminders that the deadline for that survey was May 1. This was the staff directly impacted by NPS's failure to implement our 2012 contract.
- Survey 2 (Second Phase) This week, sent out a second survey for all other staff who got their degrees outside of
 that period (before October 2015 or after November 2018). Those staff are not entitled to retro, but will be placed
 on the proper guides moving forward once the new contract is settled. That survey is due May 20.

If you have any problems filling out the surveys or any questions, send them to employeeservices@nps.k12.nj.us and cc mmaillaro@newarkteachersunion.com. You must be logged on to your NPS account to complete the survey, and you will need a copy of your transcript ready to upload.

Non-Tenure Notice


For non-tenured teachers, the district must notify you by May 15 whether or not you have been rehired for next year. If you <u>do</u> <u>not</u> receive a letter from the Newark Public Schools by May 15, 2019 informing you that your services will be terminated as of June 30, 2019, it is <u>your</u> responsibility to reply in writing to Superintendent by June 1, 2019 accepting employment for September 1, 2019.
