Contracts in Perspective



Colleagues,

There was an article on <u>NJ.COM</u> last week that helps put our new contract in perspective:

Parsippany - "members could no longer justify using "personal time without compensation" for events such as the Memorial Day parade."

In Newark, we not only kept all our personal days (FIVE THAT CAN BE USED WITHOUT PENALTY OR RESTRICTIONS) with compensation, staff now has the ability to sell back those days if they don't use them.

- Jersey City - In April, the school board in Jersey City <u>approved a 4-year contract with teachers</u> that largely providing no raises in the first year,

- In Newark, we took no freezes in this contract and even made strides in shortening our guides to help staff who were impacted by past freezes.

- Overall in New Jersey, while teachers are receiving, on average, 3% raises this year, they are also generally paying more for health benefits and recently-settled contracts have incorporated increased work time.

-In Newark, our average over the life of this contract is 3.11% with no increases for health benefits costs and no increased work time.

We removed the last vestiges of corporate reform, had no real givebacks, had raises higher than the state average, restored the MA and PhD guides, and not only increased salary for all full time and per diem staff, saw huge increases to extracurricular rates, discretionary funds, summer/afterschool rates, tuition reimbursement, etc. All in all, we consider this a huge success!

Teacher Schedule (Secondary school):		
Teachers Arrive	8:10 AM	
Teachers Report to Assigned stations	8:15 AM	
Homeroom/Period 1 Starts	8:20 AM	
• Lunch period equal to that of students		
Classes End	2:40 PM	
Teachers Depart	2:50 PM	

Note that our contract does allow for some flexibility in terms of when the school day starts and ends. BUT, a Secondary Teacher's day runs 6 hours 40 minutes.

Clerk Schedule (including Clerk 3)

The workday for School Clerks is seven hours starting 1/2 hour prior to the time pupils behind their official day and ending after seven hours of work, not to include the lunch period the clerk which shall be no less than the lunch period of pupils in the school. Clerks shall receive two ten minute breaks each day, one in the morning, one in the afternoon.

Aide Schedule (Including Community Aides)

The school day for six-hour aides shall be six hours and thirty minutes including a thirty minute duty free lunch. The starting time for six-hour aides may be subject to variations as required by the needs of the school, but in no instance shall aides work in excess of or less than six hours. All six hour aides shall be entitled to one ten minute break in each workday.


