For those who said "no" to the survey, a registration link will be sent to you as soon as it becomes available. If you have already gotten your vaccine, check out page 2 of this update to get a NTU "I Got Mine" Button. This

button was developed by the NTU to promote the vaccination of as many staff as possible and to install confidence in our return to the classroom.

SPRING BREAK REMINDER

Some staff have asked us about what happens if they travel during Spring Break. NJ guidelines say:

Travelers and residents returning from **any U.S. state or territory** beyond the immediate region (New York, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, and Delaware) should self-quarantine at their home, hotel, or other temporary lodging following recommendations from the CDC:

- If travel is unavoidable, travelers should consider getting tested with a viral test (not an antibody test) 1-3 days before the trip and again 3-5 days after the trip.
- If travelers test positive, they should **self-isolate for at least 10 days and should postpone travel during that time.**
- If travelers test negative, they should quarantine for a full 7 days after travel.
- If testing is not available (or if the results are delayed), travelers should quarantine for 10 days after travel.

Please note that if you travel during Spring Break, your quarantine would NOT be covered under the quarantine days provision of our contract, and you may have to use your days to cover it.

The IRS recently posted some guidance on what items educators can deduct on their taxes due to COVID. The NTU is posting this for informational purposes only. Consult with your accountant or financial advisor to see how this applies to you.

Please note that April 1 and April 10 are the work days before or after a holiday. To ensure that you get paid for the holiday weekend, you must take a personal day if you are going to be absent on any of those days.

You can take a sick day on those days as long as it is part of an approved medical leave. Unless it is part of an extended FMLA, you must submit a medical certificate to NBOE Office of Administrative Services within 3 days of your return to work.


