Colleagues,

As we prepare for a well-deserved Spring Recess let us reflect on what we have gone through and what we may be returning to. Let us pray and give thanks to whatever our Higher Power is; kneel, turn towards Mecca, fast and pray, pray and weep, for weeping is often liberating.

Within a month of Lockdown 2020, the NTU had produced and posted over 10 Webinars on how to move from the real to the virtual. We taught many of you how to create your first bitmoji. While teachers in non-masking Cobb County, GA were fighting a losing battle against their school boards, we were getting as many titles as we could reassigned and a paycheck.

Teachers across the country have had to fight for safety protections and PPE. Here, in Newark, we have had the benefit of resolving Covid issues through, I dare say, the first reopening committee in the country. While others were passing out hot cocoa to despairing teachers in picket lines, we were distributing thousands of masks and face shields to our members, and the community, especially the homeless, Seniors and hospitals.

As we plan to return on April 12th we do so with 50% of our colleagues already fully vaccinated, 25% one-shotters and another 15% registered for their 2nd shot by Mid-May. [Student and staff testing will be done in the schools.](#) We have been allowed to enter our locations and do return preparedness checks and schedule rehearsals. Only 39% of students have opted to return.

When they tell me that the safest place in a community is the local school, I believe them. Schools are staffed with highly educated teachers, aides, clerks, and CST's, who know how to follow instructions and walk in a straight line. Of course, it's the safest place in a community.

So, I have no qualms about returning because I know if any district can do it and do it right, it's this district right here with our members. Safety people, it's going to have to be all about safety. Absolutely everything else comes in second place after safety. Compliance? Yes, right after safety.

When we and the students return, make sure that they remember that day as the happiest day of their lives. We've all been through a lot and so have they. Like millions of children around the world they'll be entering a schoolhouse, it will only feel like a prison if you make it one.

BREAKING NEWS!! 4/1/21—As you are aware NJ Regional Day School has been open for over a month. They also have been piloting the Covid "pool testing" that will be occurring throughout the district. The testing revealed one positive pool and the roster has been quarantined and the room sanitized as per CDC. The two adults in the classroom tested negative and the students, also out on quarantine, must produce a negative result before re-entry. The rest of the building remains negative.
