THESE STUDENTS ARE LOOKING TO MAKE A "PRE-EMPTIVE STRIKE" AGAINST THE TEACHER BEFORE THE TEACHER CAN BRING DISCIPLINARY CHARGES AGAINST THEM.

ALWAYS, ALWAYS, ALWAYS, STAY PROFESSIONAL AND DO NOT LET THE SITUATION MOVE YOUR WORDS IN THE WRONG DIRECTION TO BE SUBJECT TO MISINTERPRETATION. FRUSTRATION CAN LEAD TO PERSONAL DISASTER. 
