### From the Desk of the Secretary-Treasurer



It is that time of the year...the temperature drops, the holidays are over and BOOM...MIDYEAR EVALUATIONS. Midyears are only required for teachers on a CAP. Even if it's required, the RATING that you get is FORMATIVE...it does not count. It's a checkpoint letting you know how on track you are to get a rating at the end of the year. Participation is required, meaning you can't tell your administrator that you aren't attending the meeting, but if your "portfolio" or whatever your school uses to score you is incomplete, there should not be any consequences.

I advise you to do your best to have your stuff ready so you can see how you are progressing, but if you are really stressed out and can't find the time, remember, it's better to get your lesson plans done on time and meet all your other requirements that WILL impact your annual evaluation, than to ignore them to complete your mid-year information.

Even though your mid-year does not count, if you have one, and you actively participate in it, MAKE SURE TO WRITE A REBUTTAL FOR ANY PART YOU DISAGREE ON! Rebuttal guidance is here. REMEMBER...signing your midyear (or observation or end of the year evaluation) means you had the meeting, not that you agree with your ratings. Not signing a midyear (or observation or end of the year evaluation) means nothing! You still need to write a rebuttal!




